Frontier Airlines announces Colorado Springs expansion

Frontier adds convenience and low fares on four new routes

DENVER (Feb. 9, 2012) – Frontier Airlines today announces four new nonstop routes from Colorado Springs Airport (COS) to each of Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), Phoenix SkyHarbor Airport (PHX), Portland International Airport (PDX) and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA) in May.

The new nonstop flights enable southern Coloradans to save significant time and avoid connections getting to these top destinations from Colorado Springs. Frontier will operate the new routes with 138-seat Airbus A319 aircraft. These will be the only nonstop flights from southern Colorado to Phoenix, Portland, and Seattle, as well as the only nonstop service to Los Angeles on a low-fare carrier.

Flights to these new destinations are available for purchase today with introductory fares starting as low as \$49* each way, including taxes and fees. For the first few days of sale you only can find these flights on FrontierAirlines.com, where you'll always find our lowest available fare.

Tickets for Tier 1 fares (Colorado Springs to Los Angeles, Phoenix, Portland and Seattle) must be purchased by 11:59 p.m. Eastern time, February 29, 2012; tickets for Tier 2 fares must be purchased by 11:59 p.m. Eastern time May 18, 2012 (Colorado Springs to Los Angeles, Phoenix and Seattle) or 11:59 p.m. Eastern time May 20, 2012 (Colorado Springs to Portland). Tier 1 fares shown are for travel through June 18, 2012 (Colorado Springs to Los Angeles, Phoenix and Seattle) or June 20, 2012 (Colorado Springs to Portland). Tier 2 fares shown are for travel through September 9, 2012 (Colorado Springs to Los Angeles, Phoenix, Portland and Seattle). Fares are valid only for travel originating in Colorado Springs for nonstop travel to Los Angeles, Phoenix, Portland and Seattle. Roundtrip purchase not required.
